

To remove the battery door, press and slide.



The media card is optional. If a media card was included, it might already be inserted.



To remove the media card, press the media card in and then pull it out.

 Follow the instructions to set up your email address. When your email address is set up correctly, you receive a confirmation email. To see your email, on the Home screen, tap the **Messages** icon.



Import your contacts

You can import your contacts from a SIM card or by using the BlackBerry® Desktop Software. For information about the BlackBerry Desktop Software, see the "Connecting to your computer" section in this guide. If you have a SIM card, do the following:

1. On the Home screen, tay the Setup icon.
2. Tap the SIM Contacts Sync icon and follow the instructions.

Lock your screen

To lock your screen, press the two on the top of your BlackBerry® smartphone. Set a password

On the Home screen, tap the Setup icon > Password icon.
 Select Enable > tap Set Password, and follow the prompts.

- To lock your smartphone, on the Home screen, tap the **Password Lock** icon. Record your password for future use.
