① Insert the SIM card

Depending on your BlackBerry® smartphone model or your wireless service provider, you might not need a SIM card for your smartphone.



To remove the battery door, pull up the bottom of the battery door.

② Insert the battery and media card

The media card is optional. If a media card was included, it might already be inserted. Remove the battery before you insert or remove the media card.



③ Set up your smartphone

1. If prompted, set up your BlackBerry® ID.
 2. Get started quickly with Setup!
- If Setup doesn't start automatically, on the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon.



④ Set up your email

1. On the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon > **Email Accounts** icon.
2. Follow the instructions to set up your email address.

When your email address is set up correctly, you receive a confirmation email. To see your email, on the Home screen, tap the **Messages** icon.

Import your contacts

You can import your contacts from a SIM card or by using the BlackBerry® Desktop Software. For information about BlackBerry Desktop Software, see the "Connecting to your computer" section in this guide.

If you have a SIM card, do the following:

1. On the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon.
2. Tap the **SIM Contacts Sync** icon and follow the instructions.

Switch smartphones

To move data from a previous BlackBerry® Smartphone, do the following:

1. On your computer, open the BlackBerry® Desktop Software. To get the latest software, go to www.blackberry.com/desktopsoftware.
2. Connect your new smartphone to your computer.
3. Click **Copy data and settings from another device** and follow the prompts.
4. If necessary, on your new smartphone, tap the **Setup** icon > **Email Accounts** icon and follow the prompts.

Lock your screen

To lock your screen, press the **Ⓛ** key on the top of your BlackBerry® smartphone.

Set a password

1. On the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon > **Password** icon.
2. Select **Enable** > tap **Set Password**, and follow the prompts.

To lock your smartphone, on the Home screen, tap the **Password Lock** icon. Record your password for future use.

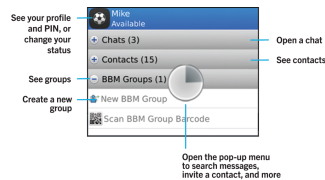
Send a text message

1. On the Home screen, tap the **Text Messages** icon.
2. Press the **Ctrl** key > **Compose Text Message**.
3. In the **To** field, type the contact information.
4. Type a message.
5. Press the **Ctrl** key > **Send**.

To insert a period while you're typing, press the **Space** key twice. Extra fees might apply.

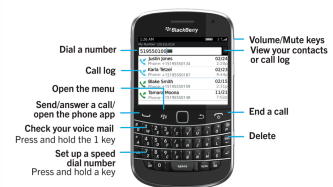
Open the pop-up menu to search messages, invite a contact, and more

Add a contact using a barcode

1. On the Home screen, tap the **BlackBerry Messenger** icon.
 2. Press the **Ctrl** key > **Invite to BBM** > **Scan a PIN barcode**.
 3. Hold your BlackBerry® smartphone so that all four corners of the contact's barcode appear on your screen and you hear a beep.

To make a call or open the Phone application, press the **Call** key.

3. Press the **Ctrl** key > **Save**.

Slide your finger up or down on the screen or trackpad.

Tap the camera icon or press the Convenience key on the right of the smartphone.

Change the flash setting

Record a video
1. On the Home screen, tap the **Media icon > Video Camera icon**.
2. Tap the **Video** icon.
3. To pause recording, tap the **Stop** icon.

Depending on your BlackBerry® smartphone model, the camera or video camera might not be supported or some camera or video camera features might not be available.

Pictures

To see your pictures, tap the **Media icon > Pictures**.

Zoom/pan
To zoom, slide your finger and thumb together or apart, or click the trackpad.
To pan a zoomed picture, slide your finger on the screen or trackpad.

Open a pop-up menu
Touch and hold the screen to open a pop-up menu.

Scroll through pictures
When zoomed out, slide your finger left or right quickly on the screen or trackpad.

Send picture
Send picture.

Rotate picture
Rotate picture.

Previous/next picture
Previous/next picture.

Play slideshow
Play slideshow.

Change your wallpaper
1. On the Home screen, tap the **Setup icon > Wallpaper icon**.
2. Take a picture or use an existing picture.
3. Press the **Done** key > **Set As Wallpaper**.
4. Press the **Done** key to return to the Home screen.

Wi-Fi and Bluetooth

To manage wireless connections, tap the **Manage Connections** icon.

Network indicators

Turn on **Mobile Network**, **Wi-Fi**, **Bluetooth**, **Wi-Fi**, **Bluetooth** technology, and **NFC**.

NFC (if supported) lets you read smart tags and more.

Turn off connections (airplane mode).

- To pair with a Bluetooth enabled device, tap **Networks and Connections**.
- To connect to a Wi-Fi network, tap **Set Up Wi-Fi**.

Copy and paste

Simultaneously touch the beginning and end of the text, then press the **Ctrl** key > **Cut**, or **Copy**.

To paste the text, press the **Ctrl** key > **Paste**.

Open a pop-up menu. Touch and hold the screen or press and hold the trackpad.

To see a video, tap the **Setup icon** > **Tutorials** > **Edit Text**.

- Sync your contacts, music, pictures, and more
- Back up and restore smartphone data
- Update your software

- On your computer, open the BlackBerry® Desktop Software.
 - If you're using a Windows® computer, click **Music**, **Pictures**, or **Videos**.
 - If you're using a Mac computer, in the **Media** section in the left pane, click **Music**.
