### 1 Insert the SIM card

Depending on your BlackBerry® smartphone model or your wireless service provider, you might not need a SIM card for your smartphone.



To remove the battery door, pull up the bottom of the battery door.

## 2 Insert the battery and media card

The media card is optional. If a media card was included, it might already be inserted. Remove the battery before you insert or remove the media card.



## 3 Set up your smartphone

 If prompted, set up your BlackBerry® ID.
 Get started quickly with Setup! If Setup doesn't start automatically, on the Home screen, tap the  ${\bf Setup}$  icon.



### 4 Set up your email

- On the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon > **Email Accounts** icon.
   Follow the instructions to set up your email address.

When your email address is set up correctly, you receive a confirmation email. To see your email, on the Home screen, tap the **Messages** icon. Data plan required.




### Import your contacts



If you have a SIM card, do the following:


- 1. On the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon.


