3 Set up your smartphone

 If prompted, set up your BlackBerry® ID.
 Get started quickly with Setup! If Setup doesn't start automatically, on the Home screen, click the **Setup** icon.



4 Set up your email

- On the Home screen, click the **Setup** icon > **Email Accounts** icon.
 Follow the instructions to set up your email address.

when your email address is set up correctly, you receive a confirmation email. To see your email, on the Home screen, click the **Messages** icon.





Import your contacts


