

Add a contact by scanning a barcode

Adding contact information to your BlackBerry Messenger contact list is easy — just use the camera on your BlackBerry Style to scan a person's barcode.

- 1. On the Home screen or in the Instant Messaging folder, click the **BlackBerry Messenger** icon.
- 2. On the Contact List screen, press the key.
- 3. Click Invite Contact.
- 4. Click Invite by scanning a PIN barcode.
- 5. Click Continue.
- **6.** Hold your device so that all four corners of the barcode appear on your device screen. Continue to hold the device until you hear the success beep.

You can also add a contact by typing an email address or PIN. If you add a person who uses SMS text messaging as a contact to BlackBerry Messenger, you can send SMS text messages to and receive SMS text messages from the person in BlackBerry Messenger. However, your BlackBerry smartphone must be running BlackBerry® Device Software version 5.0 or later.

Change sensitivity of the trackpad	Click the Options icon. Click Typing and Input . Click Trackpad Sensitivity .
Change convenience keys	Click Setup, Click Convenience Key.
Exit /Close a program	Click the key. Click Close or Shut Down , depending on program.

Check your voice mail	Press and hold the 🏢 key.
Add an extension to a phone number	Press the key and . Type the extension number.
Turn on or turn off the speakerphone during a call	Press the 📑 key on the keyboard.
Type a letter in a phone number field	Press the key and the letter key.
Set up speed dial for a contact	From the Home screen or in the phone application, press and hold the key that you would like to assign speed dial to.

Giving your contacts unique alerts

When you get messages or calls from your friends, your family or co-workers, set your notification alerts so you always know who's trying to reach you.

- 1. From the Home screen, go to the **Sound and Alert Profiles** icon.
- 2. Click Change Sounds and Alerts. Click Sounds for Contacts. Click Add Contact Alert.
- 3. Type your contact name in the Name field.
- **4.** Start typing the contact name in the **Contacts** field and the full name should appear from your list. Click to select your contact.
- 5. Under the **Contact Alert Settings**, you can personalize phone or message alerts by selecting the appropriate profile.



- **6.** You can then personalize the sound alert, visual alert, and tactical alert for that person.
- 7. Once you have made all changes, press the key and select **Save**.

 If you choose **Move to Folder**, scroll through the list and select the desired folder.




Changing your default folder for application downloads






