1 Insert the SIM card

Depending on your BlackBerry® smartphone model or your wireless service provider, you might not need a SIM card for your smartphone.





To remove the battery door, press the button at the bottom. Slide the SIM card into the slot.

2 Insert the battery and media card

The media card is optional. If a media card was included, it might already be inserted.



3 Set up your smartphone

 If prompted, set up your BlackBerry® ID.
 Get started quickly with Setup! If Setup doesn't start automatically, on the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon.



4 Set up your email

- On the Home screen, tap the **Setup** icon > **Email Accounts** icon.
 Follow the instructions to set up your email address.

When your email address is set up correctly, you receive a confirmation email. To see your email, on the Home screen, tap the **Messages** icon.






- On the Home screen, tap the Setup icon.
