### 1. Insert your SIM card, battery, and media card

To remove the battery door, press and slide the battery door down. Insert the micro SIM card. Align the battery contacts to insert the battery. Insert a media card if you have one.



### 2. Set up your smartphone

- Press and hold the **Power on/off** key to turn on your smartphone.

After the initial setup, tap **Setup** on the home screen to set up your email, social networking accounts, and BBM. Sign in using your BlackBerry ID or create a BlackBerry ID inyou don't have one. BlackBerry ID helps sync information (for example, contacts) between your smartphone and computer. It also manages your apps and services, allowing you to transfer information when you switch smartphones.

## 3. Transfer information to your smartphone

### Leave or close an app





You can leave an app just by swiping up. The app is minimized and appears as one of your Active Frames. If you want to close the app completely, tap  $\times$ .

# Wake up your smartphone Show menus and more actions

Swipe up from below the screen and release your finger half-way up. To put your smartphone to sleep, press the Lock screen key. For extra security, you can set a password that you enter when you wake up your smartphone. From the home screen, swipe down from the top of the screen and tap \$\frac{1}{2}\$ Settings > Security and Privacy > Device Password.





In an app, at the bottom of the screen, tap  $\equiv$  or  $\,:\,$  . Or, touch and hold an item on the screen.
